

## **Guest Speaker and Author:**

Frederick Matt Matthias grew up in Manhattan, New York City. He spent four years in the Air force. After discharge, he married a girl from Louisiana and they raised four children. He flew crop dusters for thirty years and later worked for a large aircraft corporation.

Horses and the Western frontier have always been within him. He raised and broke Appaloosa horses, wrote Western stories and does Western woodcarving.

Lynda Carlberg was the former director of the Calcasieu Parish Library System, 1978-1997. She was active in state, regional and national Library activities and many local community activities. She was the heart of Libraries Southwest.

The Carlberg award was established to honor the memory of a dear friend, and honor special individuals for their contributions to Libraries.

This year's recipient is Sona Dombourian, Director of the Lafayette Parish Public Library. Sona received her MLS from LSU in 1977. After graduation, she became the Administrative Librarian for the Assumption Parish Library, overseeing \$100,000 budget, the main library and 2 bookmobiles. After several years, she moved to Lafayette and became the Assistant Director of the Lafayette Public Library. Her responsibilities as Assistant Director included preparing and administering the budget and overseeing the Reference, Adult, and Circulation Service areas in the Main Library.

After moving to Lafayette, she became interested in computers and library applications. She earned her MS in CS from USL and spearheaded Lafayette Public Library's automation project, which went live in 1996.

In 2004, she became Interim Library Director. In 2005, she was selected as the Library Director. She oversees the Library's building program - a result of a \$40 million bond issue. They have opened two regional libraries and are in the planning process of 3 others, including a complete renovation of the 36 year old Main Library. Their operating budget is now over \$7 million.

Sona has served on state committees - including the LSTA



and statistics committees, LLA (and the Public Section) in several capacities -Parliamentarian of LLA, Chair of PLS, Handbook Committee for PLS (including a stint as Chair), Swap 'n' Shop Coordinator back in the 'early days', Conference Program Chair and co-chair. She also co-coordinates the (usually annual) Bayouland I Love Technology Workshop with Trudy Patterson and Jackie Choate.


