Our **Flickr** Site has over 7,900 historic photos and documents related primarily to Vernon Parish, La. The items are searchable, and are divided by folders by subject. They are free to download.

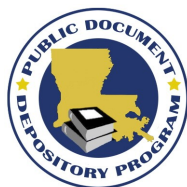

As a **Louisiana Depository**, the Library has a collection of Louisiana Documents available. Documents cover many subjects, including agriculture, government, wildlife and fisheries and much more.



Through **LoanShark**, our Library can borrow materials from other libraries through our InterLibrary loan Program. This is a free service.
